THE ADVANTAGES OF A STUDY PLAN

Study Plans are used by Christian publishers to develop balanced, trustworthy series of Bible studies that help Christians grow spiritually.

- Study plans facilitate spiritual growth of believers by determining an orderly progression of studies that consider “the whole counsel of God.”
 - Verse count per session is determined
 - A sequence of studies is developed that determine what is studied and what must be omitted because of space limitations
 - The length of background passages is ascertained to provide pertinent information to group members for each Bible study session
- Study plans are developed by curriculum experts who have advanced degrees and experiences.
- Study plans prevent theological drift as studies are created for both the group leader and group members, allowing for mutual accountability.
- Study plans are liberating for group leaders because they do not have to spend countless hours each week developing their own studies.
 - Time can be invested in serving group members, pursuing potential new members, and reclaiming absentees.

Balance is a primary benefit of Study Plans

- Studies are balanced between Old and New Testaments
- Studies are balanced between different genres of Scripture studied
 - Prophecy
 - Wisdom Literature
 - History
 - Gospels
 - Epistles
- Studies are balanced to ensure the Bible is studied holistically
- Balance is not achieved when group leaders create their own studies
