FAMILY BIBLE EXPLORATION

USE THESE ACTIVITIES AS YOU STUDY TOGETHER AS A FAMILY:



• Ask: "Who will go?"

Play a game by gathering your family together and announcing several tasks that can be completed. Consider simple tasks like getting a drink from the fridge, taking out the trash, and so forth.

To begin, ask: "Who will go get a drink from the fridge?" Encourage a family member to answer: "Here I am. Send me!" Continue until interest wanes.

Read Isaiah 6:8. Say: "Isaiah had a vision when he was in the temple. God asked who would go and tell the people God's message. Isaiah said he would tell the message."

• Play with tongs.

Acquire a few pairs of kitchen tongs. Collect a few items that can be picked up with the tongs you have selected.

Read Isaiah 6:6. Say: "The seraph Isaiah saw in his vision flew to him with a burning hot coal picked up with tongs. We have some items in our room today that we can pick up with our tongs."

Guide family members to pick up some of the items you gathered with their tongs. As family members are successful, consider inviting them to try and pick up other items until interest wanes.

• Tell about God.

Read Isaiah 6:8. Ask: "What did Isaiah say when God asked who would go? That's right, Isaiah said he would go and tell about God."

Continue: "God wanted someone to tell the people of Judah that God was going to judge them for their sin. Isaiah's task would not be easy, but Isaiah knew that telling about God is important."

Consider making a plan to invite friends over who need to hear about God's love. Work together to make your home an inviting place to tell others about God.
