SESSION 6 >> People were overwhelmed with amazement. “He has done everything well,” they said. “He even makes the deaf hear and the mute speak.” —*Mark 7:37*

SESSION 7 >> “But what about you?” he asked. “Who do you say I am?” Peter answered, “You are the Messiah.” —*Mark 8:29*

SESSION 8 >> And when the centurion, who stood there in front of Jesus, saw how he died, he said, “Surely this man was the Son of God!” —*Mark 15:39*

SESSION 9 >> Not so with you. Instead, whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant, and whoever wants to be first must be slave of all. —*Mark 10:43-44*

SESSION 10 >> They all gave out of their wealth; but she, out of her poverty, put in everything—all she had to live on. —*Mark 12:44*

SESSION 11 >> Be on guard! Be alert! You do not know when that time will come. —*Mark 13:33*

SESSION 12 >> “Abba, Father,” he said, “everything is possible for you. Take this cup from me. Yet not what I will, but what you will.” —*Mark 14:36*

SESSION 13 >> “Don’t be alarmed,” he said. “You are looking for Jesus the Nazarene, who was crucified. He has risen! He is not here. See the place where they laid him.” —*Mark 16:6*
